









All together in Bordeaux, 27th & 28th October 2025 for the

1st European Meeting of complementary local currencies!

The first European Meeting of **Complementary Local Currencies** will be held in Bordeaux Monday 27 and Tuesday 28 October 2025, at the Athénée Municipal, ahead of the Global Social and Solidarity Economy Forum - Bordeaux GSEF 2025. This will major bring event together thousand several participants and will notably feature a dedicated workshop on local currencies.

These meeting is organised by the Mouvement Sol (the French federation of local currencies), the Network of Local Authorities for a Solidarity Economy (RTES), the Gemme (the local currency of Gironde), and the City of Bordeaux, in cooperation with European several currencies, as well as national networks such as the Observatori de la moneda complementària (Catalonia, Spain) and Financité (the Belgian federation ethical finance).

Why These Meeting?

We observe that **complementary local currencies** are experiencing growing development in many European countries:

- Spain now has more than a hundred local currencies.
- Belgium counts about ten in Wallonia, and a few projects are emerging in Flanders.
- Germany has several local currencies, including the Chiemgauer, which is emblematic and the oldest in the country.
- A network of cooperatives in northern Italy is also showing increasing interest in these initiatives.
- France, for its part, stands out as a leading country in this field: it is currently the only state to have established a specific legal framework, and has more than 70 local currencies, including the Eusko (Basque Country), the most important in Europe.

Despite their diversity of forms and contexts, these currencies share common principles. However, they differ in their degree of integration into the social and solidarity economy (SSE), in the support they receive from local authorities, and in their transformative impact.

These meeting will therefore be a unique opportunity to get to know one another, share our experiences, and exchange on our practices.



A European Movement

Local currencies are directly affected by **European regulations** (Payment Services Directive, European Banking Authority, etc.), and can also access **European funding** (ESF, LEADER, etc.).

These meeting aims to explore opportunities for cooperation, and even to lay the foundations for a European network of local currencies.

A growing recognition

Local currencies now enjoy increased recognition from actors in the social and solidarity economy (ESS France, Fair, Conseil supérieur de l'ESS, Labo de l'ESS, Crédit Coopératif, Nef...), from local authorities, as well as from the State.

These days will also provide an opportunity to engage in dialogue with local and national public authorities and institutions about our shared challenges..

You are therefore cordially invited, as representatives of your local currency, to participate in this key event (free admission upon registration), and to invite local authorities, social and solidarity economy actors, and institutional representatives who might be interested to join the discussions on Tuesday afternoon.


